1 To RECEIVE Apologies for Absence

2 <u>To RECEIVE Declarations of Interest or to APPROVE such Dispensation Requests</u> None were received.

3 <u>To CONSIDER Planning Application No: DC/19/00567; Land North of Burstall Lane, Sproughton</u>

The Parish Council unanimously agreed to object to planning application no: DC/19/00567. The Council considered a number of substantive points to be raised within the objection

submission.

Cllr Gasper asked for District Cllr Busby's view of the likely direction of the Babergh District Council Planning Committee; Cllr Busby considered whereas there had been strong historical merits for the refusal of the proposed development of the Sproughton Hall Field, as this development site was included within the draft Local Plan, there would likely be no objection.

4 <u>To CONSIDER Installation and Operationof a Grid Connected Solar Farm and Battery Storage</u> <u>Facility; Land North, South and East of Flowton</u>

Cllr Gasper advised that an email had been received from the representative of Enso Energy regarding their recent submission of an Environmental Impact Assessment Screening document as part of a forthcoming planning application.

Mr J Foster had considered the document and suggested three key areas of concern to raise with the Babergh District Council planning officer. The Council unanimously agreed to ask the

planning officer to insist that an Environmental Impact Assessment should be require	d as part
of any planning application.	

The Parish Council thanked Mr J Foster for his valuable assistance and hard work in preparing a submission.

8.20pm Cllr Rawlings joined the meeting.
